Quilting Tip

When making quilts for children (or friends) add a secret pocket with a little note in it...only you and the recipient will know where it is if you disguise it well. This is great for grandchildren, you can add a new note each time you visit them.



Recipe by Request:

Pear or Apple Bunt Cake *(Jamie Kemp)*

Preheat oven to 325°

Cake combine:

3eggs beaten with 1/2 c. oil

2 c. sugar

2 c flour

1 tsp salt

1 tsp soda

2 tsp vanilla

3 c. chopped pears or apples

1 c. nuts

Pour ingredients into bunt pan and bake for 1 hr and 15 min

Glaze:

2 c. powdered sugar

1/2 c. lemon juice

2 T. butter

2 T. milk

Mix ingred. heat to melt butter then pour glaze over bundt cake
