## PIECE CORPS QUILT GUILD MINUTES

May 3, 2010

The meeting was called to order by the President, Pat Meyer at the Community Presbyterian Church after a Trunk Show program by Katie Morgan about Buggy Barn quilts. (The Cotton Shop, Muscatine, IA) Katie presented a workshop for guild members on Sunday, May 2, 2010. There were 47 members present and one guest, Donna Giddens. Darla Owen and Karen Schlup were hostesses, Donna Brown and Lisa Volden greeted those in attendance. The Roll Call question was "What are your Mother's Day Plans?"

The Minutes were approved as sent; Vicki Gentzell gave the Treasurer's Report in the absence of the Treasurer.

### Old Business

Raffle Tickets the drawing was held for the quilt. Carlene Makawski sold the winning ticket to Marci Colescott, A final tally on how much money was raised is not complete.

Tomorrow (May 4, 2010) Pat Meyer, Donna Brown, Dedra and Jenny Litherland will be giving a program on quilts at Living Community. President Meyer reported the final attendance figures for the quilt shows at the local museums in March: 232 at the Wyatt-Tootle Mansion, 1,613 at the museum on Frederick.
