**Membership** Judy O’Donnel reported that donna Giddens has joined as a new member.

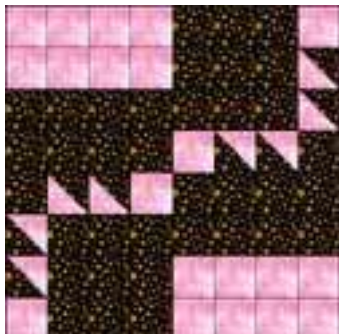
### ***Program***
