July 9, 2012

The July 9th meeting was called to order by President Kelly Lacina at 7:00 pm.

There were 56 members and 4 guests present. The Guests were Kathy Stockett, Alaine Holmes, Sharon Ritchey, Kathy Demerest and Judy steeby.

Kelly Lacina thanked the hostesses: Donna Giddens and Bobbie Foster and the greeters: Dedra Litherland and Lisa Volden.

A motion to approve the minutes as mailed in the newsletter was made by Karen Leake and seconded by Diana Garrett. Motion passed.

Treasurers Report

The treasurer, Karen Schlup, read the Treasurer's report. A motion to approve the Treasurers' report was made by Sherry Gardner and seconded by Carla Proctor. Motion was passed.

Old Business (cont'd)

Hazel Meade stated that two (2) portable quilt racks with carrying cases that are 8' 10" tall were now on sale by the Craft Guard Co. for \$139.00. Added taxes and shipping would bring the total to \$162.00. or \$324.00 for two (2) racks.

Barbara Wilkerson made a motion to spend up to \$350.00 for the two (2) new racks and Diana Garrett seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Hazel Meade also said "Thank You" to the Guild members for allowing her to borrow the Guild's quilt racks for the quilt show that was held in Gower, Mo. She said there were 159 quilts in the show.

Diana Wiedmaier requested the use of the Guild's quilt racks at the Plattsburg Quilt Show On August 24th & 25th. Motion was made by Judy O'Donnell and seconded by Hazel Meade. Motion passed.

Kelly Lacina stated there should be some kind of sign to show who donated the racks and asked that Katherine Stevenson be contacted for advice on how to do this.

Karen Schulp stated that a total of \$725.00 was made from the quilt raffle.

New Business

Kelly Lacina asked that if there were any members who were also members of the Wyatt Park Baptist Church or the Grace Evangelical church, please contact Barbara Wilkerson.

Committee Reports

Ways & Means: Carlene Makawski stated that a knife order had been sent in and should be back next week.

Carlene stated that the Panera cards were for sale. There are 6 cards per sheet and selling for \$15.00 per sheet. She stated that the cards had no expiration date, one could use three (3) of them at a time, and that they can be used at any Panera Bread store as indicated on the back of the card.

Carlene also stated that the Guild will be having a garage sale this September at the Robidoux Row Museum. She asked that members donate quilting magazines, fabric and crafts. The date will be announced at a later date.

Dedra Litherland stated that the Guild will be making a baby quilt and a lap quilt. She asked that each member make two (2) blocks, for one or both quilts that is 8 ½" unfinished and 8" finished. The baby quilt will be made up of primary colors with a white or yellow background. The lap quilt will be made of reproduction fabric or 30's fabric with a white background. She stated that she would do the quilting.

Kelly Lacina said that we still have some St. Joseph Piece Corps Quilter's Guild pens left for sale at \$5.00 each. See Carlene or Kelly, if you would like to purchase one.

Courtesy: Karen Leake stated that if anyone had information concerning a member to whom a card should be sent to, please contact her. If she is not available she stated that one could also contact Bobbie Foster and she would relay the information.

Retreats & Trips: Vicki Jackson stated that the Fall Retreat will be held September 13, 14, 15, & 16th. She said there was one position still open and that she does have a waiting list. She stated that she will be collecting the fee from members at the August meeting. The retreat will be held at the Country Cabins in Hiawatha, Kansas. The fee is \$160.00.

Charity: Barbara Wilkerson stated that a Charity Workshop will be held on August 4th. The location for the workshop has not been determined as of yet. You may work on any Charity project you like.

Beverly Rivera stated that she is making little girl's dresses for the girls of the Dominican Republic. She said she has made 26 dresses and not 96 that was reported in the May Newsletter. She says she has a pattern and invited anyone to help make the dresses.

Library: Carla Proctor stated that the bookshelf has been received and she is in the process of sorting the books in the library. She said the Guild purchased a book about how to make hand quilted postcards in the memory of Leo Gallaway. Carla explained the procedure of how to check a book out of the library.
