Special Announcement

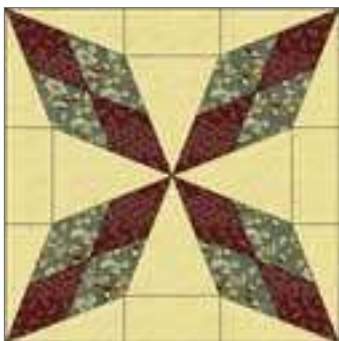
Carolyn Wolf had large zip-lock bags available for anyone to take. They were leftover from the Census Bureau and would be good to organize projects.
