The Treasurers report was voted on and motion to approve by Karen Schlup and Ginny Moore 2nd the motion.

Committee Reports:

Charity: Janie Kemp stated her and the board members held a meeting to discuss how to handle the fabric and monies set aside for charity projects.

As a result the following rules have been set up:

- The Charity chairman or a person designated by her will purchase the fabric and batting
- It was decided not to buy a roll of batting but to buy batting when it is on sale or using coupons as needed/available.
- The fabric needs to be purchased on sale/discounted or by using coupons. Only as needed no stocking of supplies.
- Reimbursements will be made only upon the presentation of a receipt.
- The Charity Chairman will give a report each meeting with the beginning balance of the garage sale funds, purchases and ending balance of monies for charity projects.
- At the end of the term of the Charity Chairman all batting, fabric that is left will be given to the New Charity Chairman.

The board felt it was good to have rules set up to handle the money and supplies for charity projects. The Charity funds are included in the treasury report, the Charity chairman will read and list the balance separately to account for those funds brought in or used on projects. This will be reported each month as necessary.

All the funds made from the garage sale should be available for Charity chairmen to purchase fabric and batting for the guild's charity projects that the Guild is involved with. David Hurd 2nd the motion all agreed.
