Minutes

July 6, 2015, 7:15 p.m.

Call to order: Following program “Challenges, Swaps, Exchanges...Oh, My!” presented by Theresa Ward of Leavenworth, KS, the July 6, 2015, meeting was called to order at 8:20 pm, at the Pony Express Museum, by President Judy O’Donnell.

Attendance: 46 members, 4 guests

Minutes: Motion to approve minutes of June 2015 meeting was made and seconded. Motion passed.

Treasury Report: Treasury Report was presented by Theresa Culver. Motion to approve was moved and seconded. Motion passed.

New Business:

- After considerable discussion, it was decided not to have a guild quilt show in October, but rather to have it in April, using space at the Scottish Rite. Rent is \$250 for 3 days which would be sufficient time to set up, have the show, and tear down. Theresa Culver and LaDonna Duncan will investigate available dates. Committees will need to be formed. Barb Miller is in charge of publicity. Janet Loveless has the guild’s quilt racks which need some repairs. Bev Lowry volunteered her husband to make the needed repairs. The group voted to reimburse his expenses. Some of the racks actually belong to Janet but she stated she wanted to donate them to the guild.

- Having been inspired by the program, decided to have a “Birthday Challenge” which will start in January 2016. Hazel Meade volunteered to organize it.

Charity

- Kay Huntsman reported there are 13 finished VA quilts turned in so far. Tonight is the last night Kayla will accept them to quilt. Other quilters in the group volunteered to help. There is a workshop on July 18 and another in September to work on quilts.

Ways and Means Committee

- The Culver’s event earned \$300. It was moved and seconded that the \$300 be used to purchase backing and batting for the VA quilts. Motion passed.

- Tickets for the raffle quilt will be sold at the Agency Quilt Show on July 25 by members who have volunteered.

Workshops

- Carlene Makawski thanked everyone who attended the “Stack’n’Whack” workshops.

- Terry Massengale announced that she needs to know tonight how many will be attending the purse workshop in September so she can order patterns (\$10).

Courtesy Donna Giddens reported that Barb Budine’s nephew, who is also Delores Foster’s nephew, passed away. Donna has also sent a sympathy card to Barb Budine for the passing of her mother.
