Old Business

The following charity projects were adopted:

Opportunity quilts (queen size) for YWCA, Hillcrest Transitional Living, and Habitat for Humanity Baby quilts and other layette items for Birthright

Quillows (35) for Royals Family Kids Camp

Three groups have volunteered to make the opportunity quilts. Diedra Litherland and Mary Gaston volunteered to quilt them. It was moved and seconded to provide up to \$175 for each of the three quilts for backing and fabric; motion passed.

Pictures of the winning quilts will be posted on the guild's FaceBook page.

Charity: There will be a Quillow Workshop on May 14, 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. at the Pony Express Museum. Supplies include 2 pieces 60"xWOF plus 2 14" squares.

Kay asked if there was interest in having new guild T-shirts. This will be discussed at next meeting. Lanette asked experienced quilters to send in "tips" for the newsletter. Also, if members want to buy, sell, trade machines, fabric, etc., they may send this to Mary Gaston for inclusion in the newsletter.
