Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Treasurer report given by Kathy Stockett. Ending balance \$8,479.96. Accepted as read.

Charity. The committee presented several ideas for 2018-2019 projects: hospice gowns and pillows, layette items for Birthright, quilts for police cars, quilts or quillows for children in the YWCA women's abuse shelter (also women in need), and baby quilts for Catholic Charities Mom Empowerment program (also outreach to elderly). It was moved and seconded to accept all of these projects; motion carried. A workshop will be scheduled on April 14 at the Pony Express Museum to work on charity projects. It was suggested that the charity committee track the number of items donated throughout the year. Funds for batting has already been budgeted.

The 2018-19 budget was presented, including amounts for a quilt show and celebration of the guild's 30th anniversary. A motion was made and seconded to accept the budget as proposed; motion carried.

Lanette Bocquin announced that she took 47 lap quilts to Carriage Square. They used them as gifts for residents. She reminded members that the busy bags are due in February so they can be mailed.

Kelly Lacina read a thank you note from Debbie Consolver for the door prize she won in December.

Carol Fangman presented the Fat Quarter Birthday Club packets for January birthdays.

Barb Wilkerson circulated a signup sheet for next year's hostesses and greeters. She also presented a request that members make their favorite 9 ½" (unfinished) block out of their favorite fabric and bring it to the March meeting for an Ice Breaker activity.

Carlene Makawski announced that the 2018 Quilt Show will be held at the Scottish Rite. Date to be announced soon. Members were encouraged to start making items for the boutique.
