Charity Items delivered in June 2018 were 12 Pillow cases to Camp Quality, 6 Baby blankets to Frederick Boulevard Baptist Church by Hazel Meade, 1 quilt to the YWCA, 10 receiving blankets, 1 baby quilt and 3 burp pads to Catholic Charities, 3 throw quilts to the SJP, and 9 receiving blankets and 1 baby quilt to Birthright. These charities are very thankful!

11 Guild members attended the June 6th workshop where they cut out 55 Hospice Gowns and 18 neck pillows. Thank you to members who helped! There will be a workshop to stuff and close the neck pillows at a later date to be announced. Bobbi Foster had 11 Hospice Gowns at the July meeting that need to be sewn. She asked 11 members to each take one to complete and bring back to the August meeting. It is a new pattern and is much easier to sew as the sleeves are not separate.

Categories for the Quilt Show are:

- Baby & Children's Quilts up to 48"
- Hand Quilted Wall Hangings and small quilts up to 48"
- Machine Quilted Wall Hangings and small quilts up to 48"
- Hand Quilted 48" and larger
- Machine Quilted 48" and larger
- Applique 48" and larger
- Antique quilts, made before 1950, will be displayed but not judged

- Check in quilts on August 22nd from 5PM to 8PM at the Scottish Rite Temple
- A maximum of 3 quilts may be entered per guild member
- Each quilt entered must have an entry blank securely fastened to the back of the quilt by a small safety pin on the upper righthand corner. PLEASE DO NOT USE STRAIGHT PINS
- Please do not enter quilts from the previous guild Quilt Show
- Only quilts made by Piece Corps Guild Members will be shown
- All Quilts will be taken down at 3PM on Saturday August 25th. Quilts will be picked up at 4PM, You must have your receipt to pick up a quilt.
- Guild members will be notified by email if there is room for more than 3 quilts.
