Minutes were accepted as emailed.

Treasurer report given by Kathy Stockett and approved.

A program and Trunk Show was presented by Tia Curtis.

## **Charity:**

Charity Items delivered in August 2018 were 3 quillows, 4 twin quilts, 2 baby quilts, 6 receiving blankets, and 4 burp pads. 5 quilts to the police department, 2 baby quilts, 6 receiving blankets, 4 burp pads and 2 bibs to Catholic Charities. 3 baby quilts, 6 receiving blankets, and 5 burp pads to Birthright. 19 hospice gowns to Mosaic Hospice. Also delivered to Grace House from the Quilt Show Boutique were Christmas Ornaments and table runners, book covers, draw string and snap purses, mug rugs, pin cushions, microwave cozies, kitchen boas and a hanging metal basket and 3 pillows to the YWCA.

**By-Laws:** Changes to the Piece Corps Quilt Guild were presented and approved. See the September newsletter for recommendations.

**Ways & Means:** A motion was made and passed to use all monies made from the Guild Boutique from the quilt show for charity projects. The money was moved to the Guilds Charity fund.

**Guild Quilt Retreat:** Barb Miller reported that Stoney Creek was booked on July 12,13,14 for a 3-day retreat for Guild members @ a cost of \$2366.39. Price will include use of the ballroom and catered beverage services for all 3 days. Cost of the retreat will be divided equally between all quilters with attendance limited to 50. A block of rooms has been reserved for retreat attendees for Friday and Saturday night for special price of \$99.00 per night. YOU MUST STATE THAT YOU ARE A PIECE CORP QUILTER TO GET THIS PRICE. Each quilter is responsible for reserving and paying for their room. Quilters must be a member of The Piece Corp Quilt Guild at this time, it might be opened to guests at a later date if spaces become available.
