Carla's Comments: Quilting tips

- When washing fabric before cutting, open the fabric so the fold line from being wrapped on the bolt is open and has a chance to fade.
- Clip loose threads & untangle threads before putting into the dryer.
- Bias binding will last longer on a quilt than fabric cut on the straight of grain because there are more threads on the edge with bias.
- Be careful not to tug and pull when using fabric on the bias.
